- (c) Community Based Organizations (CBOs) and Local Government Capacity building.

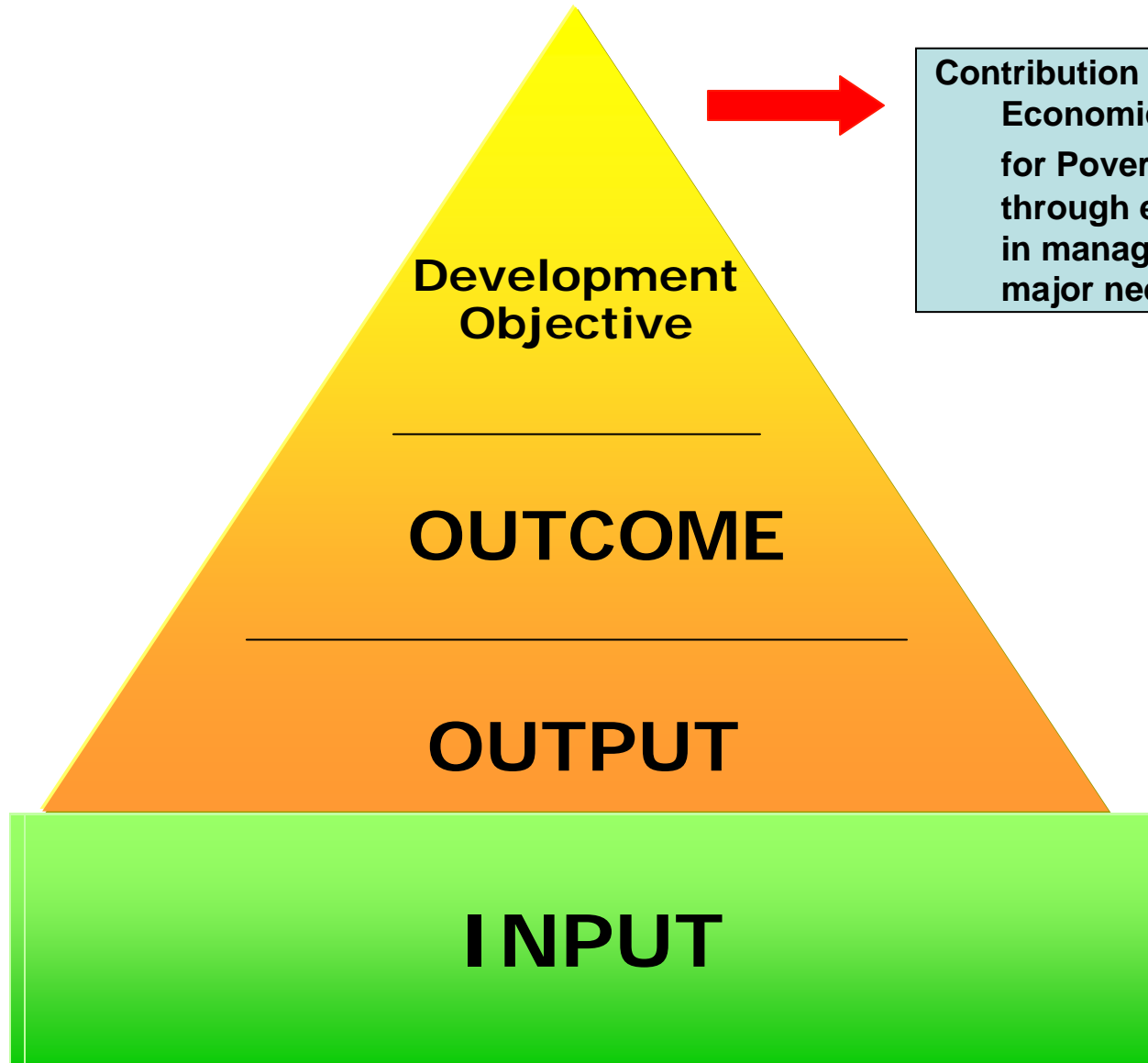
2. Social Care Services Development:

3. Communication, Monitoring and Evaluation, and Capacity Building:

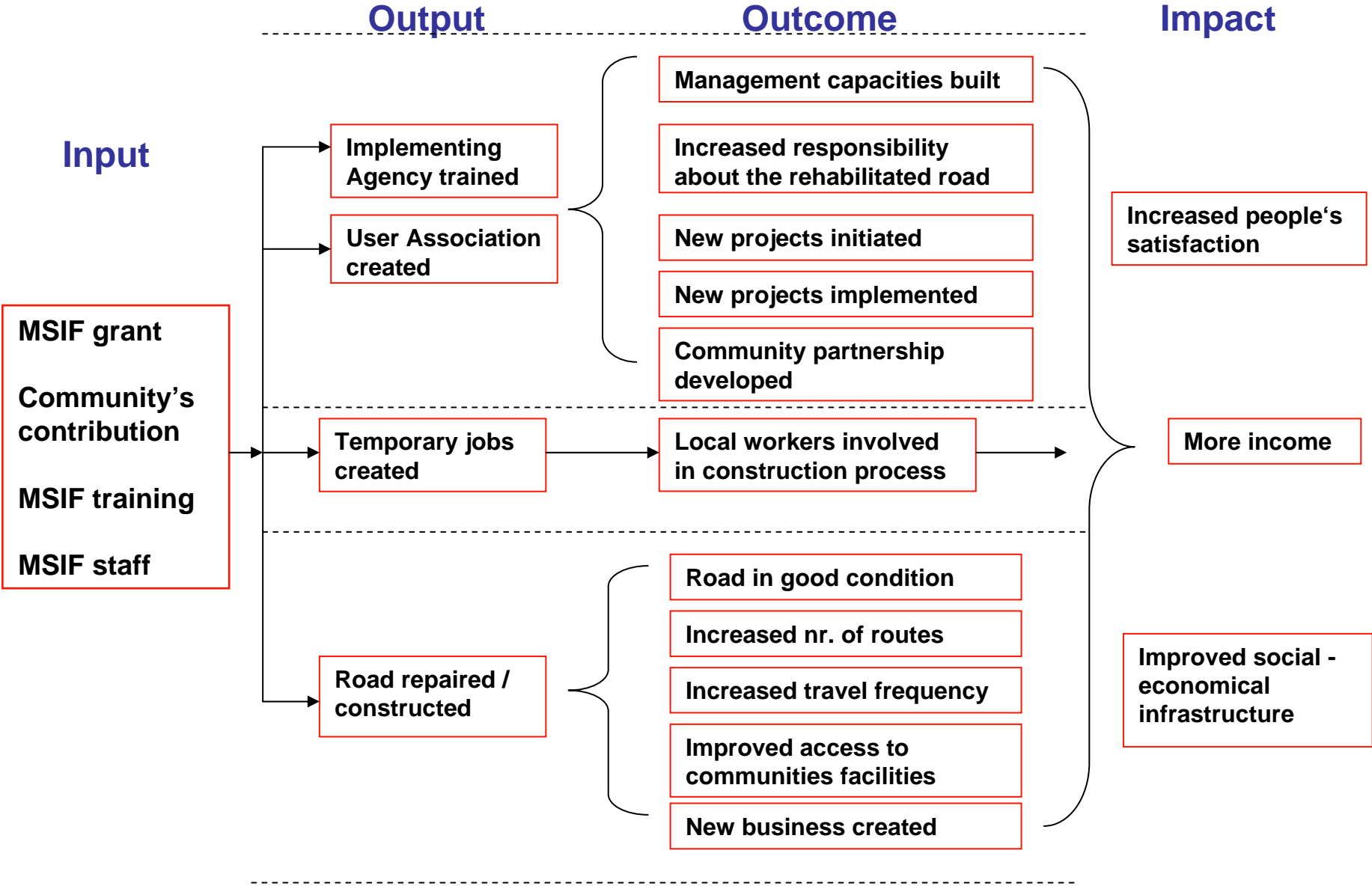
- (a) capacity building for the Government Institutions and learning policy lessons;

M&E Concept

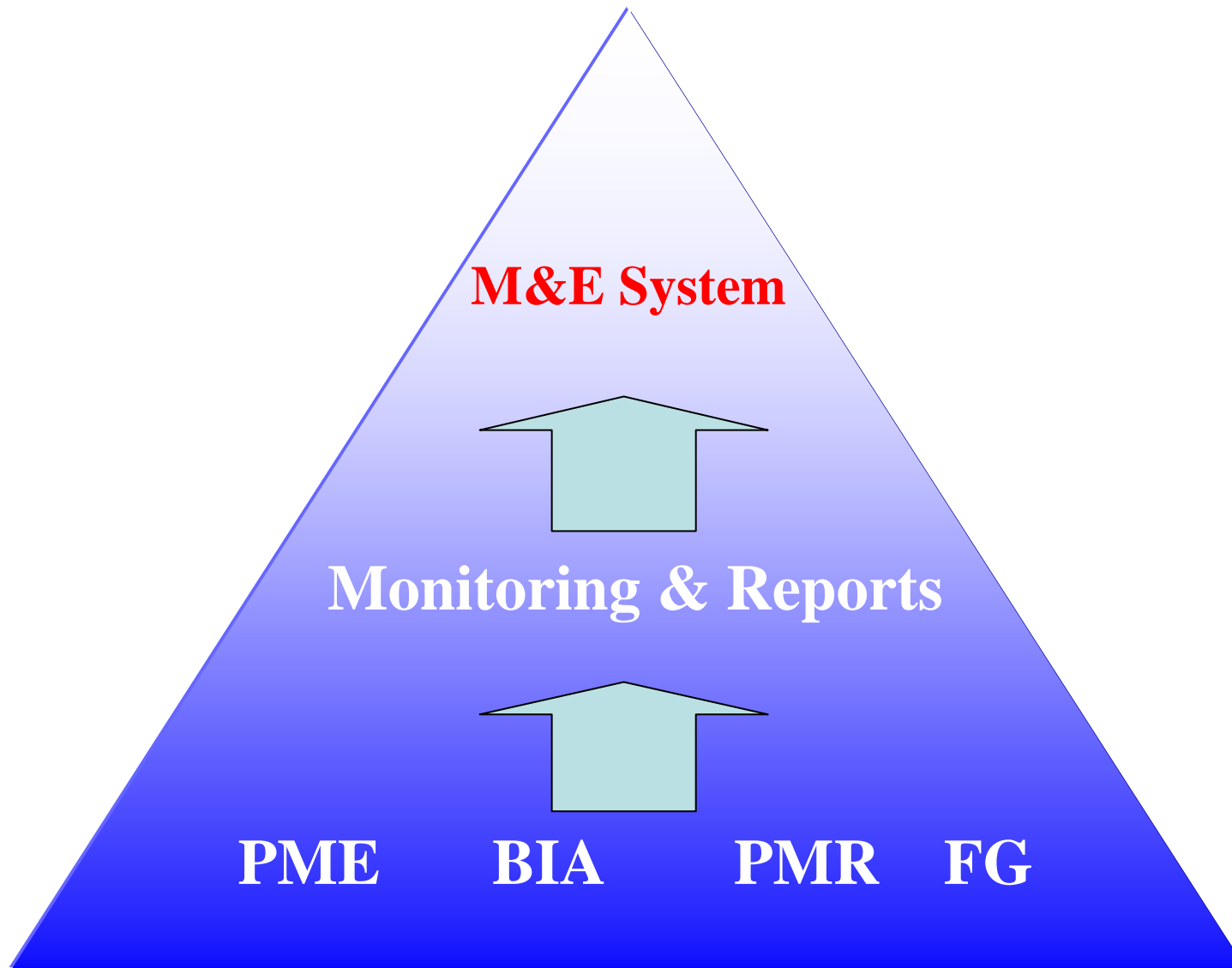


Contribution to the implementation of the Economical grow and of the Strategy for Poverty Eradication in Moldova through empowering the communities in management of their development major needs.

Sample Outcome sequence chart: Road repair/construction



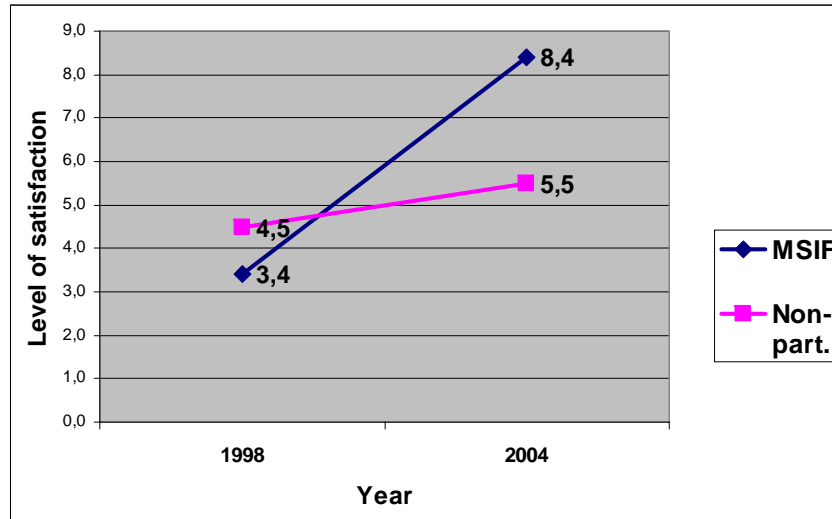
Data aggregation in MSIF MIS



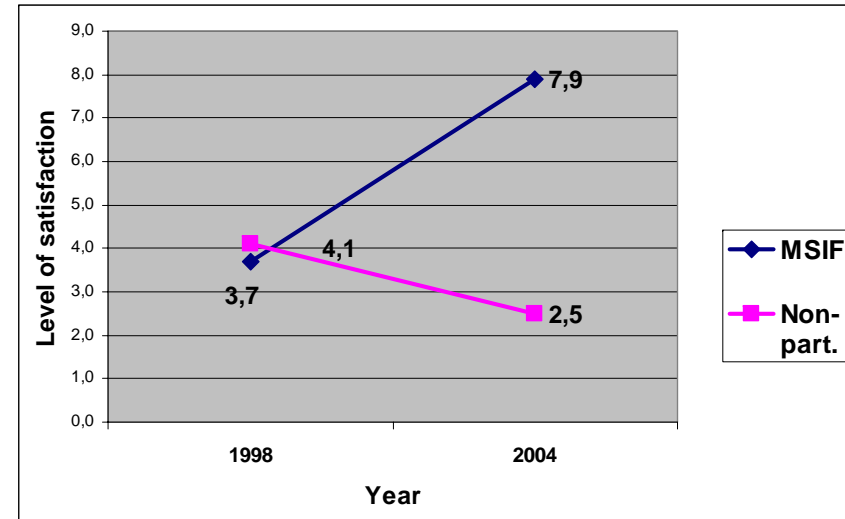
Examples from Beneficiary Impact Assessment

Water supply subprojects

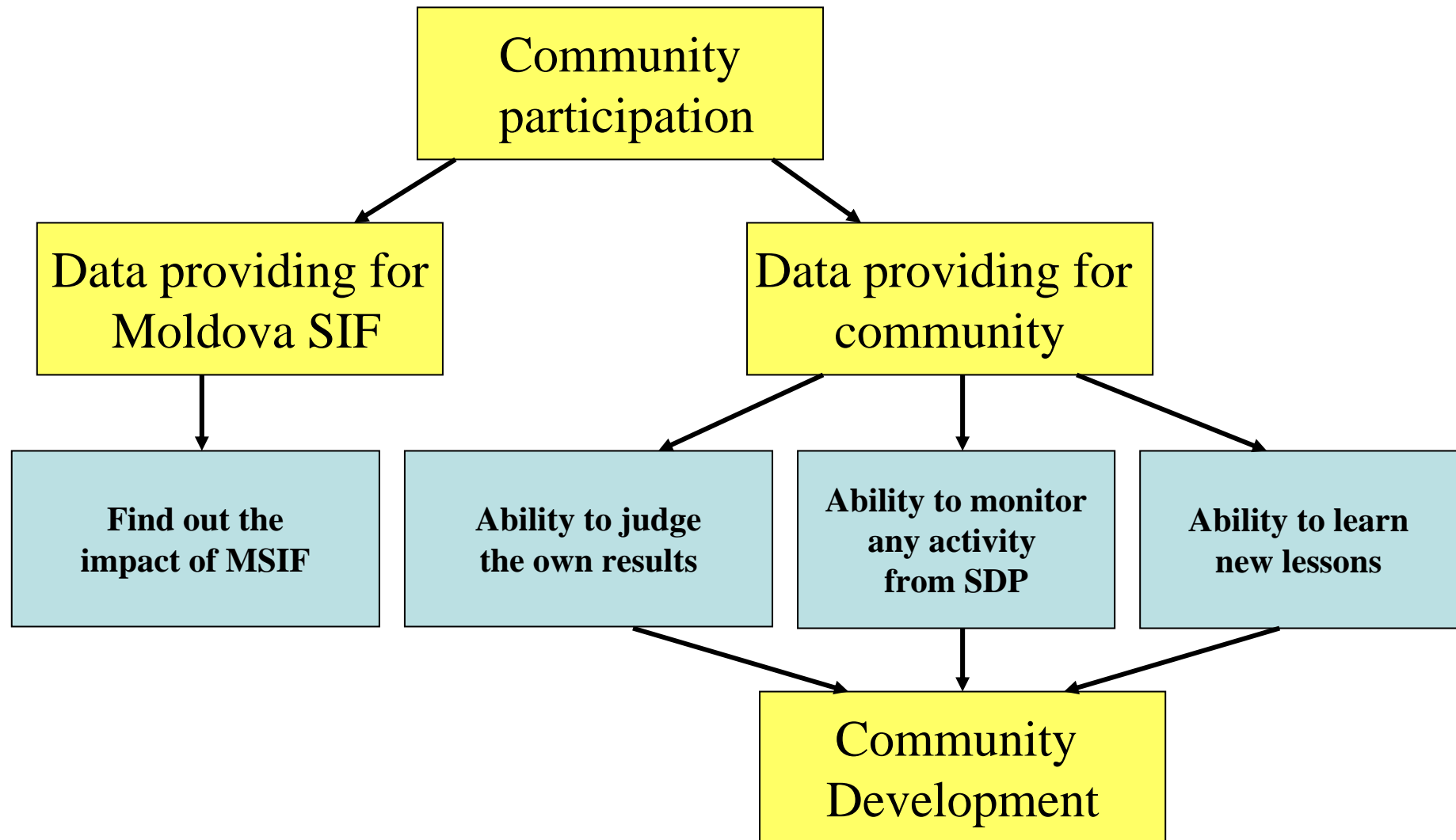


Methodology used – Differences in Differences

PM&E Concept

- Collaborative Process
- Involvement of LPA, NGO, EA, ATP in projects evaluation and taking necessary actions
- Beneficiaries evaluate the results using qualitative & quantitative indicators
- Beneficiaries collect and analyze the information, make recommendations for subproject improvement
- Beneficiaries are responsible for subproject's results and undertake corrective actions
- PM&E stress the capacity building and responsibility of all the beneficiaries to reflect, analyze, and assume the responsibilities for the implementation of the changes recommended by themselves

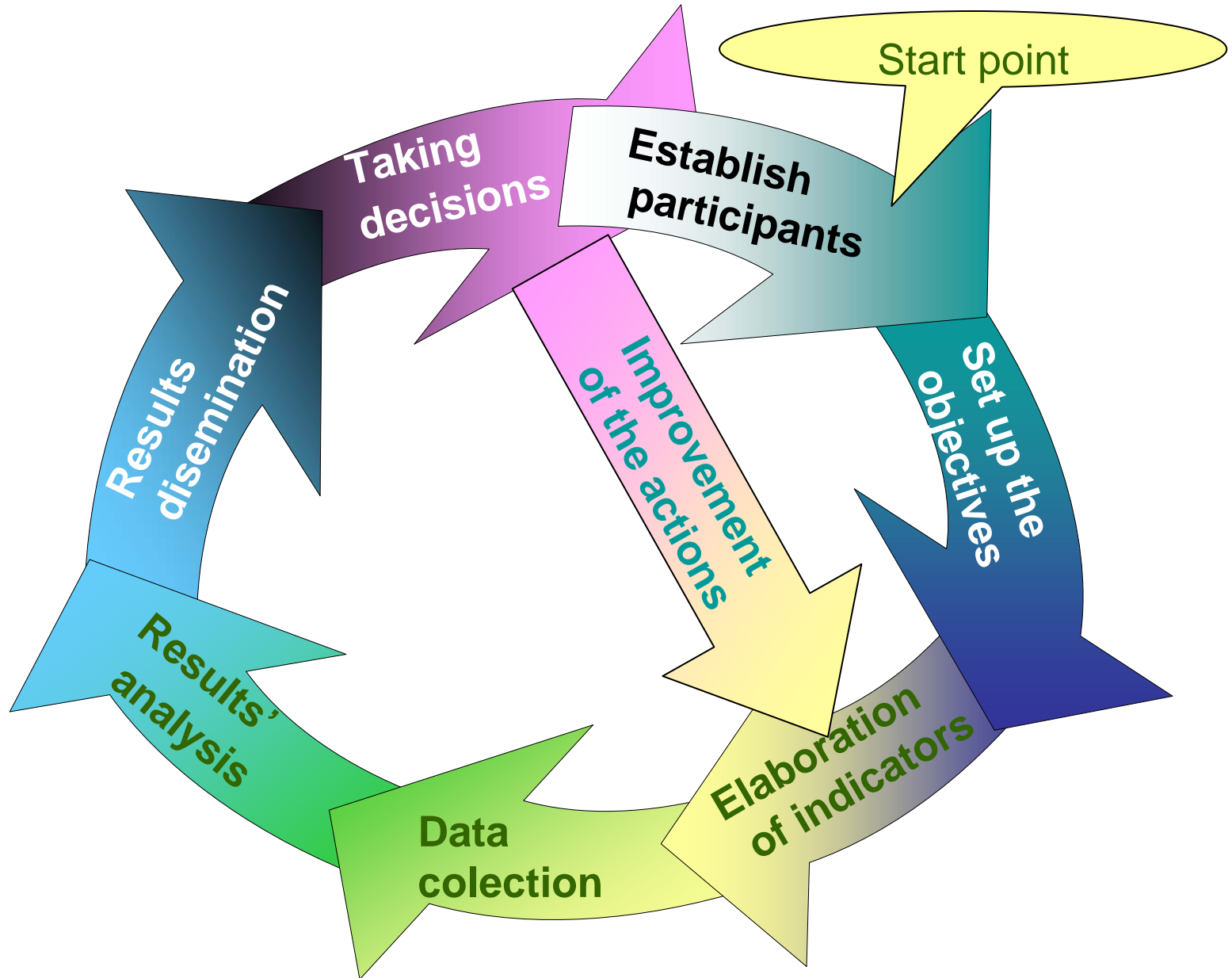

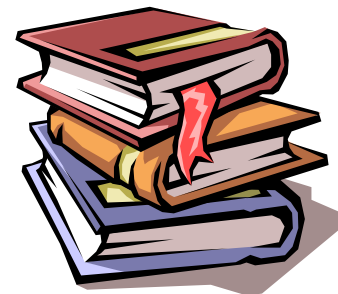

- Population's contribution in kind, money, labor
- Nr. of routes before & after project's implementation
- Public travel frequency before & after the project
- Nr. of facilities with direct access to the road
- Nr. of new projects implemented
- Cost of the new projects (work, money, in kind)
- Nr. of beneficiaries in new projects (men, women, children)
- Who is the sponsor (Community, Economical Agent, LPA, ...)
- Nr. of new business created as result of road repairs

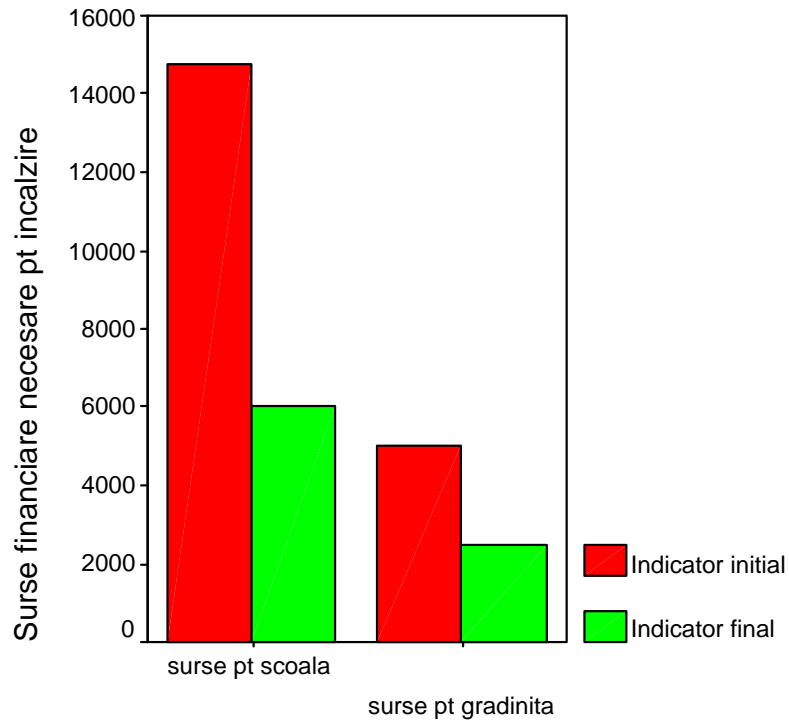

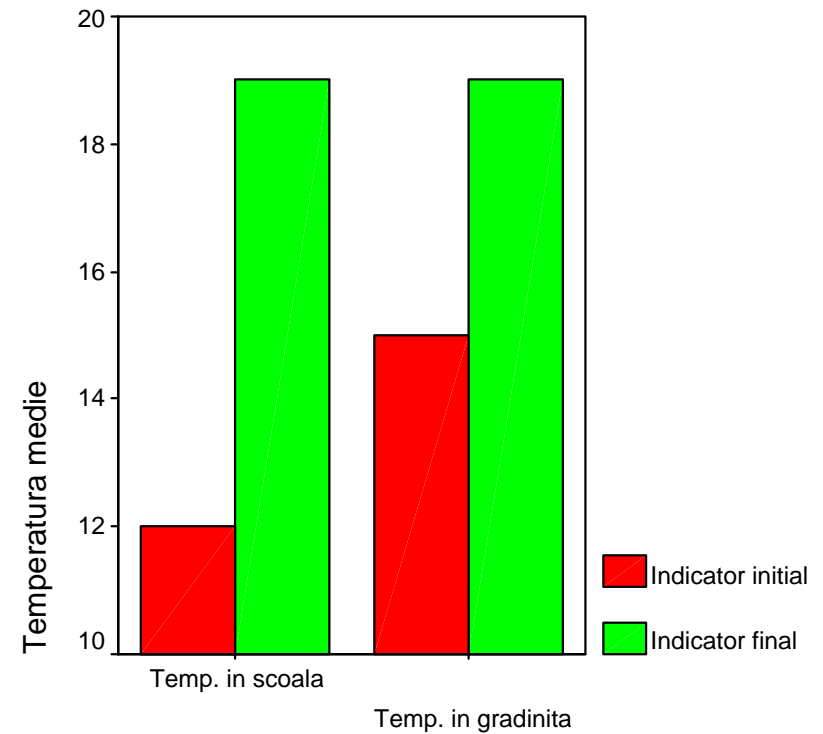
259 communities which implemented MSIF financed SPs during 2000-2003 were questioned in order to find out MSIF's impact.

Necessary sources for schools / kindergarten heating



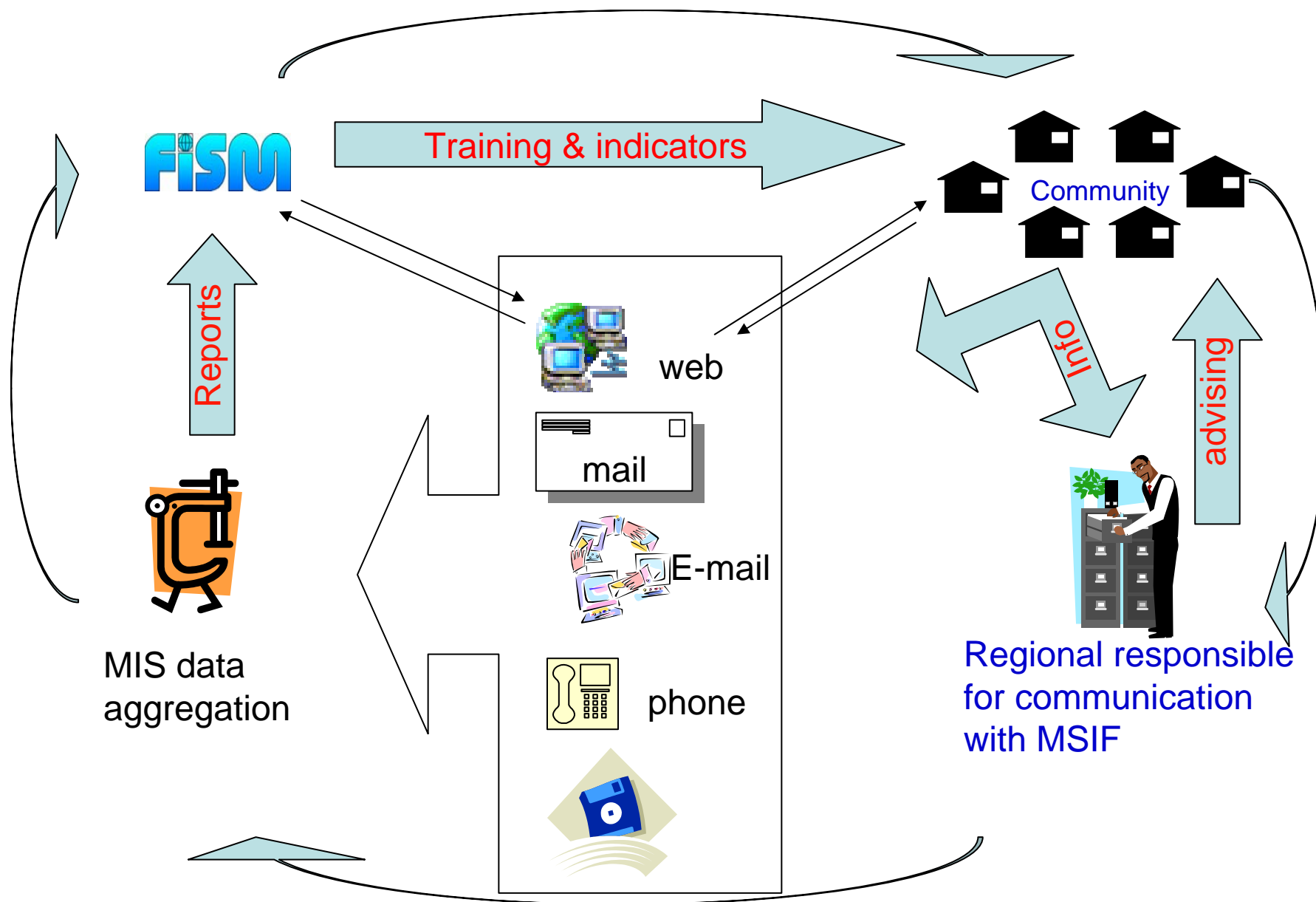
